

Namib to Falls Adventure - Southbound

15 days Victoria Falls to Windhoek - FULLY SERVICED camping

THE HIGHLIGHTS:

- 1 night accommodated in **Victoria Falls**.
- Sunset game viewing cruise on the **Chobe River**.
- Mokoros & walks in the **Okavango Delta**.
- Game drives in **Etosha National Park**.
- Optional activities in **Swakopmund**.
- Walking in the giant dunes of **Sossusvlei** and the **Namib Desert**.

ITINERARY: WGTS TOUR CODE

DAY 1: VICTORIA FALLS

The tour starts at 15h00 on Day 1 with a pre departure meeting in the hotel. That afternoon is free to view Victoria Falls, without doubt one of the greatest and most spectacular sights in Africa. Overnight **Sprayview Hotel** (or similar). **(Accommodated – B. Lunches and dinners own account)**

DAY 2/ 3: CHOBE RIVER

The following day is free to browse the local markets, to experience the many optional activities on offer in the adrenalin capital of Africa including white water rafting, bungi jumping, microlighting/ airplane or helicopter flights over the Falls and to visit the Falls (own expense). Mid afternoon we cross into Botswana we overnight on the banks of the Chobe River. Chobe is famous for its beautiful scenery, magnificent sunsets and abundance of wildlife and birdlife. We relax on a sunset game-viewing cruise on the Chobe River. Optional morning Game Drive (own account). **(Serviced Camping - B, L, D)**

DAY 4: KWANDO RIVER

Leaving Botswana we enter Namibia. Driving through the Caprivi we set up camp on the banks of the Kwando River. **(Serviced Camping - B, L, D)**

DAY 5/ 6: OKAVANGO DELTA

We continue through the Caprivi and cross back into Botswana where we travel by road to the edge of the Okavango Delta. We transfer 2-3 hours by boat to Pepere island in the delta. The following day we do mokoro and game walks on the island and the smaller islands in the area. The activities included are mokoro trips, scenic boat tours and game walks on the island.

(Permanent tented camp with shared ablutions- B, L, D)

DAY 7: KAVANGO RIVER

Departing the Delta by boat we return to our vehicle and we cross back into Namibia. We enter the Caprivi Strip and travel to Rundu where camp is set amongst the lush vegetation overlooking the Kavango River. **(Serviced Camping - B, L, D)**

DAY 8/ 9: ETOSHA NATIONAL PARK

This Park is one of the most important reserves and game sanctuaries in Africa with thousands of wild animals such as blue wildebeest, springbok, zebra, kudu, giraffe, cheetah, leopard, lion and elephant making this area their home. Floodlit waterholes at Okakeujo & Namutoni Restcamps attract an abundance of animals throughout the evening, providing us with many amazing wildlife sightings. We enjoy early morning and late afternoon game drives. Overnight Okakeujo & Namutoni Restcamps inside Etosha.

(Serviced Camping - B, L, D)

DAY 10: SPITZKOPPE

We drive south through the Damaraland region with its vast and rugged terrain. Its mountain ranges are intercepted by wide gravel plains, which run into sandy, vegetated riverbeds and hot, dry valleys. We set up camp among the boulders of the Spitzkoppe Mountains. The afternoon is free to explore the stunning surrounding area on foot. The spectacular setting of our remote bushcamp is sure to leave a lasting impression. **(Serviced Camping - B, L, D)**

DAY 11: SWAKOPMUND

Departing after breakfast we arrive in Swakopmund and spend the afternoon exploring this German colonial town. Accommodation **BON Hotel Swakopmund**. **(Accommodated – B. Lunch & dinner own account)**

DAY 12/ 13: SESRIEM/ SOSSUSVLEI

Our journey takes us south through ever changing scenery to our camp located on the edge of the Namib Desert. We enjoy a sunset walk in the dunes surrounding our camp. The following morning is an early departure for Sossusvlei, stopping in the dune belt to witness the changing colours of the world's highest sand dunes. We undertake a 5km walk to Sossusvlei and Deadvlei. In the afternoon we enjoy a short hike through the Sesriem Canyon. **(Serviced Camping - B, L, D)**

DAY 14: WINDHOEK

Departing after breakfast clients are transferred to Windhoek. Overnight **Hotel Safari** (or similar accommodation). **(Accommodated – B. Lunch & dinner own account)**

DAY 15: WINDHOEK

Morning is free to explore the capital city of Windhoek before transfer to the airport for onward flight. **(B)**

This itinerary will depend on local conditions.
